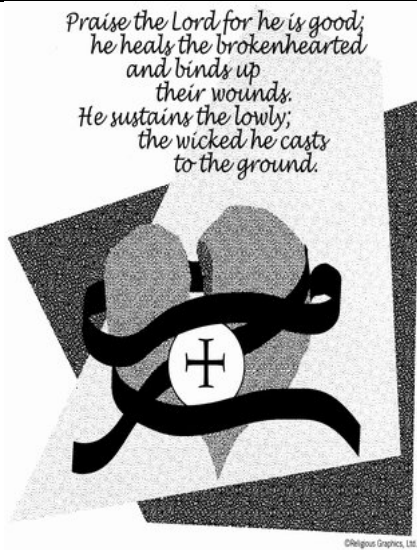

23rd Burn Time—

???Where do the ashes used for Ash Wednesday come from??? Answer: Collect all your old palms NOW and bring them to church to be burned on February 23rd. Look for a large purple box in the gathering area on February 15th and 22nd. These palms will be burned and used for our Ash Wednesday Masses on February 25th. (Palms are sacramental and are to be burned only when discarded). This will help us greatly! Palms will NOT be collected after February 22nd. (you'll have to hang onto them until next year!)
